





Results on screen: Rules of origin fruits & nuts (tariff code chapter 20: preparations of fruits)

Description of product

Working or processing, carried out on non-originating materials, which confers originating status

Preparations of vegetables, fruit, nuts or other parts of plants; except for:

Manufacture from materials of any heading, except that of the product, in which the weight of sugar[10] used does not exceed 40 % of the weight of the final product

Manufacture in which all the materials of Chapter s 7 and 8 used are wholly obtained otherwise than by vinegar of acetic acid

Footnote 10: the weight of fruit sugar and of sugar added to preparations is considered

Rules of origin: crayfish chapter 03: fish and crustaceans

Crustaceans, whether in shell or not, dried, salted or in brine; crustaceans, in shell, cooked by steaming or by boiling in water, whether or not chilled, frozen, dried, salted or in brine; flours, meals and pellets of crustaceans, fit for human consumption Manufacture in which all the materials of Chapter 3 used are wholly obtained



Rules of origin: apparel – overcoats chapter 62

Description of product

Working or processing, carried out on non-originating materials, which confers originating status

Articles of apparel and clothing accessories, not knitted or crocheted; except for:

(a) LDCs Manufacture from fabric (b) Other beneficiary countries Weaving accompanied by making-up (including cutting) or

Making-up preceded by printing accompanied by at least two preparatory or finishing operations (such as scouring, bleaching, mercerising, heat setting, raising, calendering, shrink resistance processing, permanent finishing, decatising, impregnating, mending and burling), provided that the value of the unprinted fabric used does not exceed 47,5 % of the exworks price of the product 64
